

THUMBS UP FROM STUDENTS



Recently, we held an online survey among the students who participate in the programs of Leadership, Culture and Christianity (LCC) - the student club affiliated with LOGOS campus ministry. The purpose of the survey is to measure how well we are doing ministry and meeting the needs of students. A total of 26 respondents were received within a 2 week window. This includes 3 non-Christians who responded to the survey.

The results are a big thumbs up! Here are some of the survey responses.

Theology over Pizza

Our main weekly gathering is called Theology over Pizza, which is a gathering for students to ask their questions, share their thoughts over slices of good pizza. We asked students to rate how well we are doing in creating "a safe space for honest questions and reflections, and for mutual engagement and learning" at Theology over Pizza. **72% strongly agreed** with the statement, while the rest (28%) agreed. There were zero disagreements.

Program Spotlight: PRAYING FOR EGYPT With Coptic Christians

On March 5, 2014, Leadership, Culture & Christianity (LCC) - the student club affiliated with LOGOS— co-hosted with the Coptic Christian Students Association (CCSA) at York a World Day of Prayer service.

The World Day of Prayer is an annual service organized by a global movement of Christian women. In Canada it is sponsored by the Women's Inter-Church Council of Canada. Every year, a particular country is focused for the service. This year, that country is Egypt. As a result, we decided to approach the Coptic Christians at York to organize the service together. What better way to pray for Egypt than to pray with Egyptian Christians?

So, on March 5, the two groups of LCC students and CCSA students joined together to worship and pray. We invited a guest speaker, Tisoni Mary Botros, wife of a Coptic priest, to speak about the role of women in Christianity. The two groups enjoyed some fellowship time over snacks later. It was the first time the Coptic Christians have participated in a joint service with other Christians at York.

Rating LCC (the student club)

When asked to rate the student club as a whole:

80.8% agreed to strongly agreed that LCC is a supportive community for them.

73.1% agreed to strongly agreed that LCC has helped them in their spiritual journeys.

88.5% agreed to strongly agreed that they have experienced a gracious and loving environment at LCC.

76.9% agreed to strongly agreed that they have gained a better understanding of the biblical worldview thanks to LCC.

Rating Chaplain Chong

When asked to rate Chaplain Chong's performance, 69.2% of respondents rated him as "Excellent—he really knows his stuff & is very pastoral". The rest, 30.8%, rated him as "Good—he is knowledgeable & helpful."

Students had the opportunity to write any comments and the comments were very positive, many asking us to "keep up the good work!"
